

## The Stewardship Toolkit

### General Instructions

Each month a set of comprehensive materials will be available at the [Stewardship Resource Center](#). It may be a good idea to provide other members responsible for various parts of your stewardship ministry with the Username and Password to your account at the [Stewardship Resource Center](#).

These materials may be customized and re-printed up the number of members you stipulated when you ordered. The materials come in two formats:

- † **Microsoft Word** for easy editing and customization. Add the church logo or local thoughts and references.
- † **Adobe Acrobat** for simple printing and copying/pasting into other documents you create.

The “Annual Plan” (attached) shows which materials will be available each month. It is a good idea to review this periodically in order to anticipate any scheduling needs of Bible study group meetings, printing deadlines, etc.

#### Monthly Communications

If you have elected to include one of our monthly inserts in your “Toolkit,” schedule it regularly to be included in the bulletin or newsletter, (and in email or website communications if you receive the digital format).

#### For Your Bulletin or Website

The “**Generous Reflections**” series of stewardship messages can be easily copied/pasted into your bulletin or website each week.

#### For your E-mail Communications

The “*e-Stewardship*” missives can be included in mid-week emails to the congregation.

#### Youth Stewardship Education

- † “*Calling All Kids*” is a handout series intended for grades K-6.
- † “*Young Stewards’ Corner*” is a handout series intended for grades 7-12.

#### Adult Stewardship Education

- † Each month you will receive a devotional meditation on stewardship that can be handed out to the entire congregation or used in smaller groups.
- † “*Money Matters*” is a handout series to help people understand the concepts of personal financial stewardship from a practical and biblical perspective for the entire congregation or used in smaller groups.

#### Letters from the Pastor

You have ten letters to choose from throughout the year. Have the pastor edit them to provide personal tone and style, local references, in addition to the church logo, etc.

#### Bible Studies

Schedule Bible study groups once a quarter to get a deeper understanding of true generosity.

#### Stewardship Sermons

Four sermons on stewardship are provided for the pastor to preach once a quarter.
